Transfer and Retention of Blinn College Students (from 1999 Fall Semester to 2000 Fall Semester)

Introduction and Methodology

Preparing students to transfer to senior colleges and universities is one of the major missions of the two-year college. This report documents the extent and characteristics of the transfer activity of Blinn College students over a one-year period. The degree to which Blinn College students persist in their studies at any public institution of higher learning in Texas is also examined.

Information contained in this report is the result of longitudinal data collected by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board (THECB). The THECB data focuses on the preceding Semester location of all students enrolled in a Texas public two-year college for the Fall 2000 Semester. All data has been disaggregated into three sets of data: graduates, non-graduates and combined over-all. For this report “graduates” refers to any student who received a degree or certificate during the academic year. In this report “over-all” refers to the combination of the group of graduates with the group of non-graduates during an academic year. It should be noted that the THECB data does not include students who may have transferred to private colleges or out-of-state institutions.

Blinn College Transfer Students

The Blinn College 2000 transfer rate of 24.3% is the highest transfer rate of all the public two-year colleges in Texas. The second highest in 2000 is Ranger College (enrollment 827) with a transfer rate of 17.9%. The corresponding statewide transfer rate is 10.1%.

Of the 1999 Fall Semester Blinn College students who were at Texas public senior colleges and universities by the 2000 Fall Semester, 75.3% were enrolled at the College Station campus of Texas A&M University, with an additional 6.85% enrolled at Sam Houston State University. The next most popular transfer institutions for Blinn College students were Southwest Texas State University (with 4.24%), University of Houston – University Park (with 1.93%) and the University of Texas at Austin (with 1.74%). These five senior institutions account for 90.0% of the 1999 Fall Semester Blinn College transfer students. See Section I for a complete list of the Texas public senior colleges and universities to which the 2000 Fall Semester Blinn College students transferred.

Blinn College Retention Rate

Due to the nature of the data upon which this report is based, the Blinn College retention rate refers to the percent of the 1999 Fall Semester Blinn College students who were enrolled at Blinn College for the preceding Fall Semester. With the Blinn College transfer rate being more than twice the state transfer rate, it is not surprising that the Blinn College retention rate of 38.3% is slightly below the state average of 41.2%. Combined, 62.2% of the 1999 Fall Semester Blinn students were either enrolled at Blinn College for further coursework or had transferred to a senior college or university, while the corresponding statistic at the state level was 50.9%.

Students Identified As Not in Higher Education

The “Not in Higher Education” Category refers to students who were not enrolled in a public Texas institution of higher learning for the 2000 Fall Semester. Most of the students in this category were no longer enrolled at any higher education institution as of the 2000 Fall Semester. It should be noted that 70.2% of the 1999 Fall Semester Blinn College students were still enrolled in a public Texas institution of higher learning one-year later. The corresponding statistic for the average public two-year college in Texas was 55.9%. According to their current practice, the reporting system of the Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board cannot identify students enrolled in private Texas colleges, nor out-of-state colleges. Therefore, using the THECB data, it is not possible to distinguish between students enrolled in private colleges or out-of-state college and those students not enrolled at any type of higher education institution.

Transfer and Retention Rates for Minority Students

Blinn College’s transfer rate for all ethnic groups exceed the corresponding transfer rates at the state level. However, as shown in Data Sheet 9, there was an appreciable difference between the transfer rates of Blinn College students according to student ethnicity. The transfer rate for Black non-Hispanic students was 12.0%, while the transfer rates for the White non-Hispanic and Hispanic Blinn students were 26.2% and 18.5% respectively.

The Blinn College retention rates for all ethnic groups except the Hispanic group closely resembled the corresponding statewide statistics. The retention rate for Black non-Hispanic Blinn students was 37.9% while the corresponding state rate was 36.5%. At Blinn College, only 39.6% of its Fall 1999 Hispanic students returned to Blinn College for the Fall 2000 Semester. The corresponding state statistic was 44.8%.

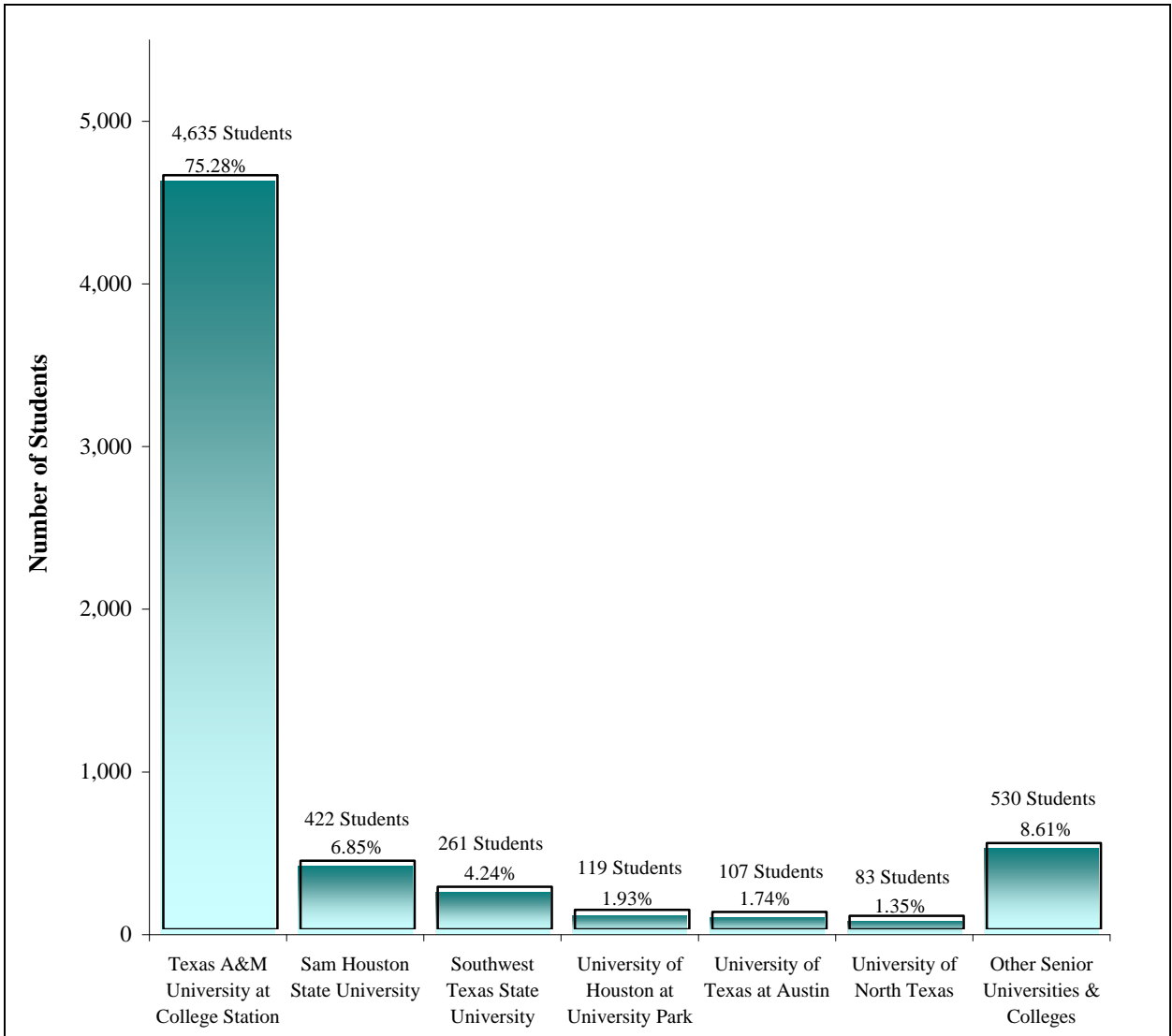

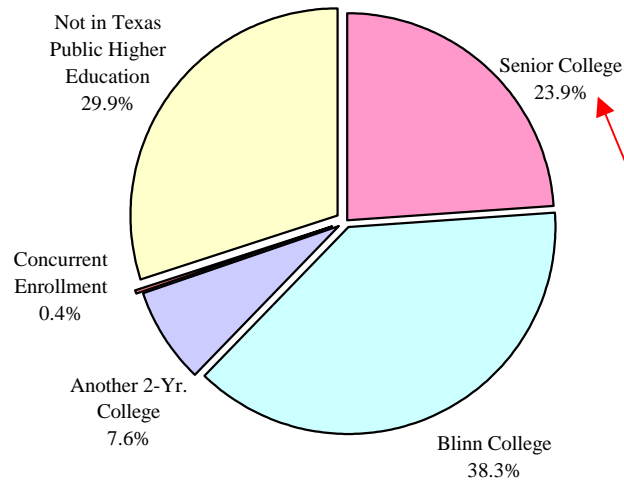

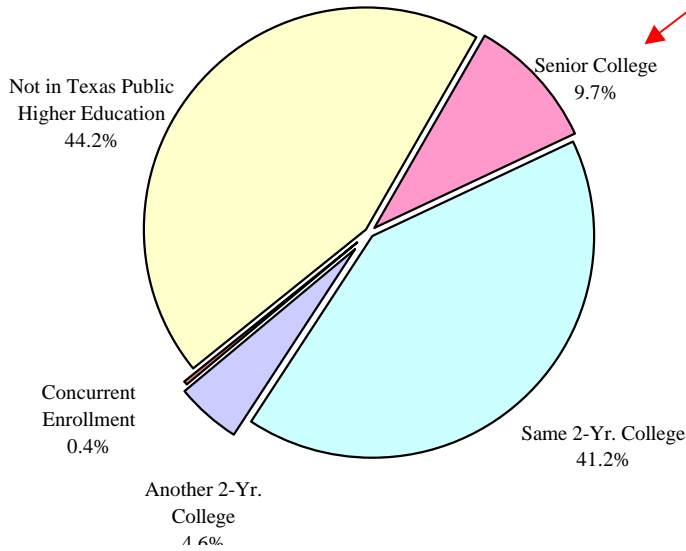
