Updates and Discussion

- Dr. Becky McBride reported on the following Enrollment Update:
 - Preliminary numbers There has been an 7.7 % increase from last fall on the Bryan Campus
 - An overall 2.52% increase district wide
 - Two surveys were sent out on a national pole
 - 1. GradGuard and College Plus Survey -
 - 47% of two-year students considered withdrawing
 - 53% of two-year students value their education
 - 2. Public Agenda and USA Today survey -
 - 49% believe the economic benefits of a college degree
 - 61% believe public higher education should be paid for by govt.
 - State Trends-
 - 2019-2021 community colleges experienced 12% decline in enrollment
 - Enrollment statewide is 4.58% less since 2019
 - 1.10% increase in public university enrollment

 - Bryan Campus has 44 programs offered
 - 17 academic partnerships with other universities
 - 25 co-enrollment programs at Rellis campus
 - Bryan campus Library Extension and New Fine Arts Building
- Dr. Joyce Langenegger reported on the following programs:
 - o Future Works Academy
 - Navigator- A mentoring program matching faculty/staff with students
 - On-line training
 - Digital transformation
- Mr. Jay Anderson reported on the following workforce programs:
 - Discussed pathways and structure students can choose from several programs
 - Apprenticeships- Credit free hands-on experience, and able to go straight into the workforce
 - Health Profession programs Certificate and AAS degrees
 - Blinn district has 37 AAS degrees
 - Adult Education & Literacy
 - 372 enrolled
 - TWC Scholar of the year award
 - On track to exceed all 1st Qtr. Metrics
