













# Preposition Visuals

## A visual representation of some common prepositions

A preposition is a word placed before a noun phrase to show relationships of meaning between two parts of a sentence, usually how the parts are related in space or time.

The nine most frequently used prepositions are these:

at	by	for
from	in	of
on	to	with

Destination	Position	Destination	Position
to 	at 	(away) from 	(away) from 
on (to) 	on 	off 	off 
in (to) 	in 	out of 	out of
