- Blinn employees – must have valid Blinn ID to be served.
- Blinn employee dependents – be accompanied by parent or guardian OR copy of parent or guardian Blinn ID

- If you will be registering your dependent on this day without your dependent present, you will need to have your dependent complete the FERPA release form

- ApplyTexas application must be submitted prior to being able to register
- Transcripts
 - High School transcript required for all students with 0 - 12 semester hours completed
 - College transcripts from all institutions attended
- Test scores – if applicable
- Bacterial Meningitis immunization record – if applicable

- Test scores – if applicable
 - Student must complete the TSIA exam prior to being advised or registering for classes. The following exemptions may apply:
 - SAT – 5 years from date of test; minimum combined verbal and math score of 1070 with a minimum of 500 on both critical reading and math
 - ACT - 5 years from date of test; minimum composite score of 23 with a minimum of 19 on both English and math test
 - TAKS – 5 years from date of test; Minimum TAKS ELA score of 2200 with a written composition score of 3 or 4 and minimum math score of 2200.

- Please review your myBlinn account to ensure that you or your dependent are registration ready. If you need assistance, please contact Admissions and Records at your campus.
- Students must be advised prior to attending early registration
 - We highly recommend that employees and their dependents meet advising prior to spring break to take advantage of early registration.

- Wed., Oct. 12 – Winter Minimester and Spring 2017 schedule available to students.
- Fri., Oct. 14 - Employee/Dependent Early Registration for Winter Minimester and Spring 2017.
- Mon., Oct. 17 – registration for Winter Minimester and Spring 2017 begins for currently enrolled students.
- Mon., Oct 24 – registration for Winter Minimester and Spring 2017 begins for new students.

- Thurs., Dec. 1 – payment for Winter Minimester and Spring 2017 due by 5 p.m. (Pay Go begins Dec. 5)

- Students are required to pay at the time of registration after the scheduled drop date for each term.
- PAY IN FULL means your account balance is zero or you have the following applied to your account to cover your balance: financial aid, third party contract, installment payment plan or scholarships. You may select the IPP option online when you register, which will require a down payment of one quarter to one-half of total charges, depending on when you make the IPP. Some fees apply.
