	Submit a High School Transcript (an in-progress high school transcript will suffice until the fina one can be sent)
	Test scores for placement purposes (TSI or Official exempting test scores and documentation)

	College Transcript (you must submit a college transcript to receive credit for all college credit including dual credit courses)
