

UIL GUIDELINES	The UIL Conflict Pattern (slightly modified) is followed. Contestants are not permitted to compete in conflicting events at Regional.
CONFLICT PATTERN	Coaches should take the appropriate steps to see that the Spring Meet District Director and the alternates are notified. If a student who has followed the UIL Academic Conflict Pattern earns eligibility to compete at the regional level in more than one event and finds that he or she has a full or partial conflict in the two events, he or she must notify the Regional Director about the conflict at least five days prior to the meet. If a regional contestant cannot attend the Regional Meet, the contestant's principal or coach must notify the District Director and request that he or she contact both the alternate and the Regional Academic Director. Only one substitution may be made on an academic team advancing from district. The substitute must give the contest director a letter or substitution form signed by a campus administrator to certify eligibility, unless his or her name already appears on the regional entry form. If more than one member of a team is unable to compete, the alternate team will then advance to competition. A student <u>will not</u> be allowed to enter a contest room late without prior permission from the contest director . Late entry in Calculator Applications and Number Sense is not permitted. If a contestant must leave early to go to another event, arrangements where permitted in the contestant plan must be made with the contest director prior to the beginning of the contest.

AWARDS	Awards for all academic events will be available to the winners in Academic Building, classroom no. 1 immediately following each contest—but only after the official results have been posted. Awards include first- through sixth-place medals and first-place team plaque.

WINNER'S INFORMATION	Information regarding the 2009 UIL Academic State Meet is posted on the UIL Web site at www.uil.utexas.edu . Except for Coaches' Packets for L-D Debate, information packets will not be mailed to schools or handed out during the regional meet verification meeting. Coaches and contestants must go to the UIL Web site for tentative schedule, UT parking, UT campus map and other vital State Meet information. Responsibility for knowing times, dates, and sites of State Meet events rests solely with coaches and contestants.
AWARDS	Awards will be available in the auditorium at the conclusion of the contest. Awards include plaques for the two advancing schools of the One-Act Play Contest, gold medals for the best actress and best actor, silver and bronze medals for the all-star and honorable mention casts, and fifteen gold medals per advancing company.
