REFUND POLICY - For classes that meet more than eight (8) times:

To receive a full refund, the student must notify the division of Applied Technology, Workforce & Economic Development forty-eight (48) business hours (or 2 business days) before the course start date.

- an 80% refund will be given before the second class
- a 50% refund will be given before the third class
- no refund will be available after the third class

Refunds require a minimum of six (6) weeks to process. Students will NOT receive a refund immediately.
