

CONSTITUTION OF THE RADIOLOGY TECHNOLOGIST ASSOCIATION OF BLINN COLLEGE

Chapter I: Name

The name of this club shall be Radiology Technologist Association of Blinn College ("R" TABC).

Chapter II: Purpose and Function

Section 1: Purpose

The purpose of this club is to develop leadership qualities, to promote professionalism, and to enable the members to become productive members of society.

Section 2: Function

- (a) To develop leadership qualities
- (b) To raise funds and enable the members to attend seminars, and activities
- (c) To enrich the community.
- (d) To establish/maintain a Radiology Technology Program Development/Improvement

Chapter III: Policies

Section I: Members

Members shall pay dues and help with fund raising activities in order to participate in club trips and activities. A point system is used to calculate status for club activity participation. Members, who have not accumulated a preset number of points, will be ineligible to utilize club funds for student activities.

Section 2: Membership

Members of this club shall be students of the Blinn College Radiologic Technologist program.

- (a) Former students of the Blinn Radiology Technologist program are eligible to be members, but may not vote at the meetings.

Section 3: Membership Fees

- (a) A fee will be paid by each member of the club at the beginning of each semester.

(b) The fee amount will be voted on by the general membership at the beginning of each semester.

Chapter IV: Voting Procedures

Section 1: Nominating and Electing Officers

The voting procedures will follow parliamentary procedures.

Chapter V: Nominating and Electing Officers

Section 1: Qualification:

(a) All candidates for the offices of president, vice-president, secretary, reporter, student government representative, and treasurer will be from the senior class.

(b) All candidates for the offices of 1st vice-president, 2nd vice-president, assistant secretary, assistant treasurer, assistant student government representative, and assistant reporter will be from the freshmen class.

(c) All candidates and officers must maintain a passing grade in each course to be elected to or hold office.

(d) All candidates and officers will not currently be on disciplinary probation at time of election, and will forfeit office if placed on probation during term of office.

Section 2: Elections:

(a) Officers will be nominated and elected.

(b) Elections will be held during the fall semester. Each class will elect their perspective officers.

Chapter VI: Officers

Section 1: All officers must be active members of the club.

Section 2: The officers of the club shall be: President, Vice-President, First Vice-President, Second Vice-President, Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, Reporter, Assistant Reporter, and Student Government Representative, and Assistant Student Government Representative.

Section 3: All officers shall serve for a term of one year or until their successor has been appointed. All officers may be re-elected.

Chapter VII: Duties of Officers

Section 1: The president will preside over all senior class meetings and officer meetings of the club and perform all duties consistent with his/her office.

Section 2: The Vice-President shall acquaint herself/himself with all duties of the President. If the President is absent or office is vacated, she/he shall act as President.

Section 3: The First Vice-President will be elected from the first year student class. The First Vice-President shall have all rights and privileges as the senior officers. The First VP will act as President of the freshman class.

Section 4: The Second Vice-President shall acquaint herself/himself with all duties of the First Vice-President. If the First Vice-President is absent or office is vacated, she/her shall as a First Vice-President.

Section 5: The Secretary shall keep a correct and permanent record of the RTABC meetings and officers meetings, maintain correspondence, document attendance, and perform all duties that usually pertain to the office of Secretary.

Section 6: The assistant secretary shall assist the secretary.

Section 7: The Treasurer shall receiver disperse RTABC funds. The Treasurer shall make monthly full financial reports which shall be included in the minutes.

Section 8: The Assistant Treasurer shall the assist the Treasurer.

Section 9: The reporter shall be responsible for informing the media of RTABC. The reporter will also keep the RTABC members informed of current acclivities. The reporter is also in charge of production of the class year book. The reporter shall co- chair the year book committee.

Section 10: The Assistant Reporter shall assist the Reporter.

Section 11: The student government representative shall attend Blinn Student Government meeting and keep the RTABC members abreast with club policies/procedures. He/she will submit proper paperwork to obtain approval for all club activities.

Section 12: The Assistant Student Government Representative shall assist the Student Government Representative

Chapter VIII: Meetings

Section 1: Class Meetings

(a) The club shall hold monthly meetings and as the need arises.

Section 2: Officer Meetings

(a) Special RTABC/meetings may be called at any time by a majority of the officers. Members shall be notified at least one day in advance.

Chapter IX: Committees

The officers shall establish committees as deemed necessary to aid the club in carrying on its activities.

Section 2: The committee members will be volunteers.

Section 1: Amendments to this constitution may be made by a two-thirds vote at any meeting
