* Students running for office must have a 2.0 GPA to apply for Senator, 2.5 to run for the Executive Board, and a 3.0 for president. All students must hold twelve hours at the time of filing and meet the GPA minimum requirement for the office. Failure to meet these qualifications will render the student ineligible to run for election.

CAMPAIGN GUIDELINES FOR SGA OFFICE

1. Posters may be placed only on classroom bulletin boards and not on the walls or windows.
2. Do not place posters or banners on any exit or entrance glass doors.
3. Please limit literature to 1 per classroom, per candidate. In hallways, posters must be posted on bulletin boards.
4. No fliers or other literature is to be placed outside of buildings or on car windows. This includes shoe polish or window chalking on vehicles.
5. Campaign materials are limited to no more than five (5) feet in length.
6. The candidates must remove all posters and banners by 6 p.m. on the final day of election.
7. On voting dates NO campaigning will be allowed in the student center.
8. All campaign literature that is to be posted or distributed on campus, including fliers, cards, posters or any other material, must first be approved by Bennie Graves, Director of Student Activities. Office is located in the Student Center office.
9. Campaigning is allowed on campus only.
10. Candidates are responsible for the action of their helpers.
11. Only currently enrolled students at Blinn College-Bryan may help a candidate campaign for office.
12. And videos to be shown during the campaign must be submitted for approval to Mr. Graves office by Monday of campaign week.
13. Each candidate will have 1 table provided by Student Services to use for campaigning.
14. All candidates must attend the nominations meeting prior to the election.
15. Any violation of the above stated regulations by a candidate or someone acting in behalf of a candidate will be subject to elimination from the election.
