NEW BUSINESS:

- Natural/Physical Sciences

1. Course Changes: BIOL 1308, 1309, 2404

- a. Elmer presented. Requested to do so together. Non-majors Bio I, II and A&P. Changes are adding a course fee. Michelle Trubenstein., Charles Smith. seconded the motion to consider as a batch. Motion by Richard Hobbs, seconded by Shawanda Stanford. Motion Carried.

- Arts/Kinesiology/Agriculture

1. New Courses: MUEN 1122 and 2122 Creating a course to separate out two wind Ensemble classes. Elmer asked about progressing from 1122 to 2122 – one is for Freshmen, and one is for Sophomore. Will this impact credits on the degree? (George Guajardo) Generally they will only take one unless they are a music major and would be an elective within the degree. Elmer Godeny moved and David Fleeger seconded to consider as a batch. Motion passed. Max Hibbs moved and Elmer Godeny seconded. Motion passed.

2. Course Changes: MUEN 1125 and 2125 Title changes for those two courses. Shawnda Stanford moved, Richard Hobbs seconded to consider as a batch. Motion passed. Motioned by Michelle Trubenstein, seconded by April Kincaid. Motion passed.

3. Course Deletion: MUSI 1158 – Deborah Vavra. Deletion to match the ACGM. Motioned by April Kincaid and seconded by Elmer Godeny. Motion passed.

- Humanities

1. Program Change: Philosophy-AA Presented by Anna Hall. Adding PHIL 1304, an online course, to degree plan to allow students to choose which religion course to take for the degree plan to allow students to complete the degree online. Charles Smith moved to vote and seconded by Deborah Vavra. Motion passed.

- Health Sciences

1. Program Change: AAS-Surgical Technology Michelle Trubenstein presented. MATH 1314, 1324 or 1342 are being added to the degree plan to make the MATH requirement more flexible and follows accrediting bodies. Karla Flannagan moved and Max Hibbs seconded. Motion passed.

2. New Program: AS-Health Science Nursing Developed at the request of the PTEC with Bellville HS. Focused more on Nursing but can work to focus on any of the Allied Health degrees at Blinn and 4-year classes. Repackaging the classes but not totally changing them. Max Hibbs moved and Karla Flannagan seconded.

3. Course Changes: SRGT 1260, 1361, 2460 Michelle Trubenstein presented and asked for them to be considered as a group. 1260 goes from 128 contact to 160, 1361 from 240 to 288, 2460 from 284 to 288. Overall degree plan is 1 hour a week less of clinical hours and meets accreditation requirements but does not impact credit hours. Elmer Godeny moved and Shawanda Stanford seconded to consider as a batch. Motion passed. Elmer Godeny moved and April Kinkaid seconded. Motion passed.
