

Analysis Notes


- *Completion Rate* is defined as the proportion of course completions (any mark earned other than drops or withdrawals) divided by the total number of student enrolled.
- · Completion Rate includes any earned D and F marks for a given comparison.
- Greater values for this metrics are evaluated as more positive as they indicate increased levels of student success.
- These metrics are theoretically leading indicators of student graduation and/or transfer.



Course Completion Rate by Academic Year




Course Completion Rate by Semester







Course Completion Rate by Gender




Course Completion rate by Ethnicity




Course Completion Rate by Academic Disadvantage
