

COURSE CONTENT

The **Course Content** area is where you can view and navigate through the course materials and activities.

Access the course overview, bookmarked topics and upcoming events.

Navigate through the course materials by clicking on the module headings in the Table of Contents. The number next to each heading tells you how many incomplete items there are within it.

Accessing Content

When you click on a module, a list of topics is displayed in the right-hand panel.

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- A small **dot** next to the topic indicates that it has not been completed
- A small **checkmark** indicates that it has been completed.
- At the top of the page, there is an **overview bar** that shows your progress.

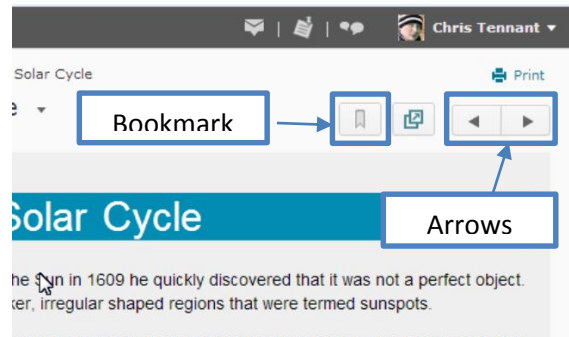

Navigating within a Module

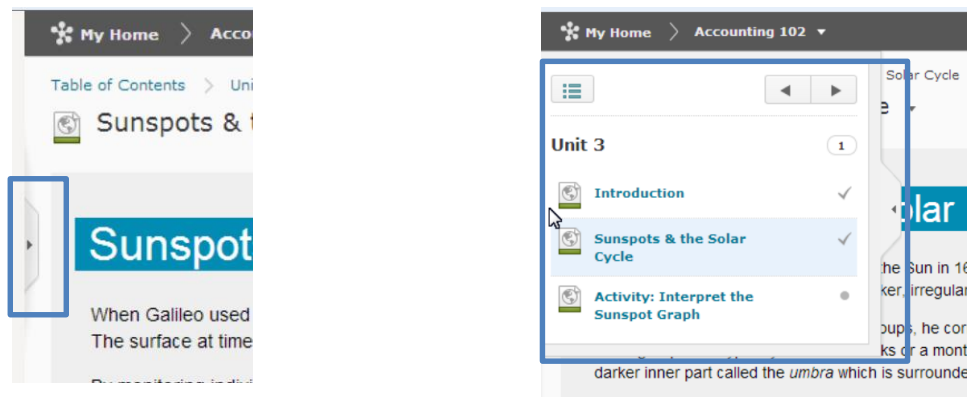
To move through a module, click the first topic.

If you want to, you can click on the **Bookmark** to add this to your bookmarks area.

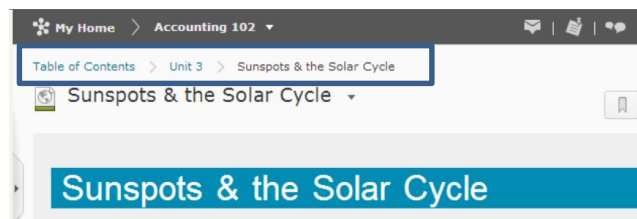
You can navigate through the topics using the **Arrow** buttons.



On the left hand side, click on the button to reveal a **slide-out panel**. This panel allows you to see the table of contents if needed. You can jump from topic to topic using the slide-out panel. You may also use the arrows in the slide-out panel to navigate through the modules.



When you are navigating through a module, you will see **breadcrumbs** at the top that will allow you to navigate back to the content area. If you go back to the content module after completing a topic, the dot will change to a checkmark.



When all topics in a module are completed, a **checkmark** appears next to the module name in the Table of Contents sidebar.
