Addendum to Articulation Agreement between Blinn College & Lamar University

Blinn College ("the BC") and Lamar University ("the LU"). BC and LU agree to the following:

I. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE/INTENT

The purpose of this Addendum is to outline the specific program-to-program agreement components not specifically addressed in the **BC** and **LU** Articulation Agreement, dated November 1, 2017 ("Agreement")

This Addendum sets out the terms and conditions of the articulation of students transferring from the BC Associate of Science in Business Administration (BC Program) into the LU Bachelor of Business Administration in General Business (LU Program). This appended degree map has been reviewed by the appropriate administrators and faculty at each institution. All other terms and conditions stipulated in the Agreement shall remain in force and fully applicable to this Addendum.

II. PROGRAM ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- **A. BC** students entering **LU Program** are subject to all admissions provisions outlined in the general **BC** and **LU** Agreement.
- **B. BC** students entering **LU Program** must have a 2.0 GPA Requirement.
- **C. BC** students entering **LU Program** must have earned a "C" or better in ENGL 1301, ENGL 1302, and MATH 1314, if applicable.

III. SERVICES PROVIDED TO BC BY LU

LU agrees to:

- **A.** Accept **BC** coursework as outlined in the attached degree map and course equivalencies.
- **B.** Provide periodic feedback regarding the performance of **BC** students that have transferred into **LU Program** as permitted under the federal Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA).
- C. Provide opportunities for **BC** students to become acclimated with **LU** through visits and/or activities coordinated with the **BC** faculty, if applicable.
- **D.** Honor the graduation requirements and degree plan set forth within the **LU** course catalog in effect at the time of the student's acceptance into **LU's** institution.
- **E.** Provide transfer informational material to **BC** as well as materials needed for promotional and recruiting purposes.

IV. SERVICES PROVIDED TO LU BY BC

BC agrees to:

A. Disseminate LU degree and transfer recruitment materials to **BC** students.

- **B.** Provide LU with on-college opportunities to recruit, advise, and provide informational materials to **BC** students.
- C. Coordinate with LU faculty and staff to provide informational sessions for BC students.
- **D.** Coordinate with LU faculty and staff to co-market programs to local high schools.
- **E.** Meet with **LU** faculty and staff each spring for the purpose of amending the degree map if necessary.
